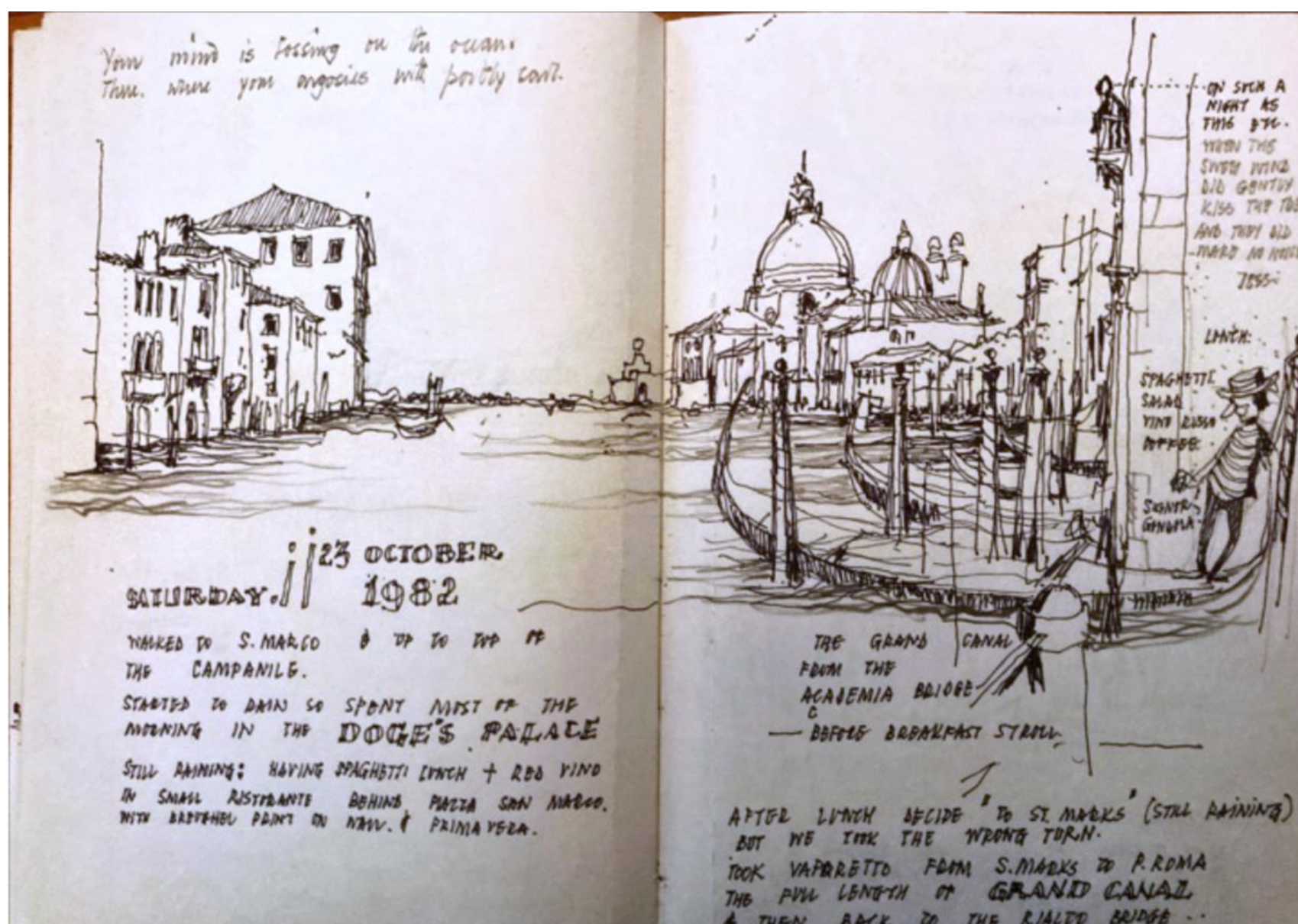


Denis Mason Jones Award for freehand sketching 2023

The Denis Mason Jones Award for freehand sketching was created in memory of the distinguished Leeds Architect of the same name. Throughout his adult life Denis kept meticulous notebooks, filled with sketches of buildings, family activities, holidays, cartoons and stories for his four children, all in his very distinctive style.

A prize fund of £2000 is available to be awarded at the Judges' discretion

All entries are to be submitted by 5pm on **Thursday 12th October 2023.**

A shortlist will be selected, with the Winners announced and presented at the WYSA Awards Evening on **Thursday 19th October 2023.** – Keep this date free!

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. The competition is open to Architects and Architectural Assistants working or living in the Yorkshire region, and Students from the five Schools of Architecture: Leeds University, Leeds Beckett University, Sheffield Hallam University, University of Huddersfield and University of Sheffield. Due to the versatile nature of the architectural profession, it is not required for the entrant to be employed at the time of submitting work.
2. Entries must be the work of an individual.
3. Entries must be an **original hand drawn sketch** created for this competition, completed in the past year and must be freehand sketches that are created on site, rather than drawn from photographs.
4. Entries must be accompanied with a completed entry form. Each drawing should be authenticated by the entrant, i.e., signed and dated on the reverse of the work.
5. Work must not exceed **A4** in size.
6. In addition, a digital scanned copy of the drawing will be required for judging, a digital exhibition, and social media.

7. A jury will be selected and announced by West Yorkshire Society of Architects.
8. The decision of the jury is final and binding
9. By submitting any works to WYSA the author allows WYSA a licence to use the works for WYSA publicity purposes.
10. Any personal data submitted will be used solely for the competition purposes and will not be shared with outside interests.
11. Shortlisted Artwork must be taken to the night of the awards on the specified date.
